

This is an overview of the actual book "The Big Picture." Kind of like an abbreviated "Cliff's Notes" for the FULL book. It provides a potential reader enough information regarding the book's content to determine if we want to invest the extra money and time to actually buy and read the entire book. This work takes on some of the more perplexingly difficult questions in life, such as: 'the true meaning of life' and the "origin of the universe." This is a 'philosophic' interpretation, and not particularly logical. It also avoids (like the plague) the major controversy of "what is the root of consciousness?" At .99 cents, this summary is a good value to help you decide whether you are interested in purchasing the entire book; which is one of the reasons I have personally found "Instaread" to be a useful service.

This book is crazy cool. I mean, it is not often that you come into contact with a book that is as deep scientifically and philosophically as this one. You will probably have to read the summary 3 times to get all of the concepts contained here in. This is some deep stuff! I do think the author takes it a little too far almost trying to discredit a grand creator (God) by explaining it with science. I prefer to think of my spirituality and science mind as not being mutually exclusive. Perhaps we can use science to explain God. Einstein rather famously said you can not look at the Universe and not think God exists. I think God has an organized mind. Thus, he probably used some organized method while creating everything and everyone. Thus, much of what he has done can be explained scientifically.
