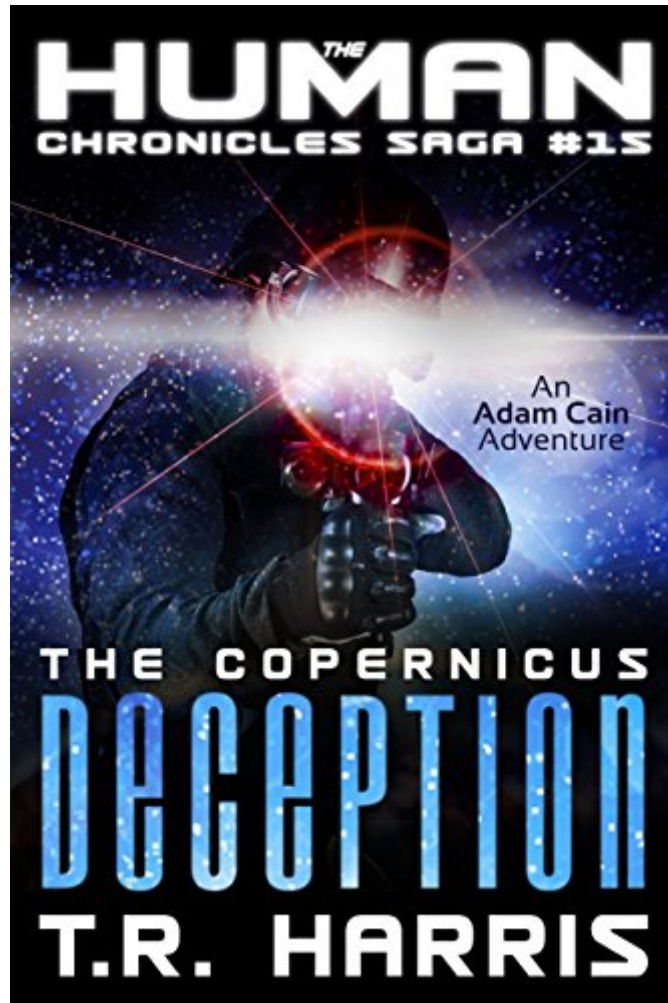


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The Copernicus Deception (The Human Chronicles Saga Book 15)

I love this series of books and I have from the very beginning but this book was not impressive. After finishing the book, which was only 90% of the pages, I was left hanging as to what I had just paid for. The last 10 % was an intro into a new book series and the story I had just read was just not up to the quality of the previous books in this series. My hero, Adam Cain, got beat up and locked up on page after page of the storyline. The hero of Earth and of the galaxy got beat up by everyone he met. Not a whole lot happened and it seems that the entire book was used just to introduce a new character in the series and then the story suddenly ended. Adam makes a discovery of an ancient artifact and in 200 pages we still don't know what it does. I don't feel like I got my money's worth and I didn't feel entertained with this book like I did with the others in the series. This for me was a flop and I regret paying money to read this. I gave 3 stars for this book and that is not good when compared to my previous enthusiasm for this series of books. This one fell flat onto its face!

T.R. Harris just keeps coming up with new ways for Adam Cain to be a hero, even if he would otherwise not want to be. This latest edition has a very interesting new character that we still don't know much about other than it is very old. I can't wait to see what happens with this object/being in the next book. Copernicus was kind of a jerk. But that fits in to the story. I don't think we've seen the last of him. And those darn Mane-Heads are so egotistical it is sickening. If they aren't in charge, they don't know what to do with themselves. And I always love when he brings back Keleb and Jym. They are so cute, but their characters as aliens are definitely developed well. But no super-human mutants in this story. Will they be in the next book? I can't wait to find out! And when this book ends, Andy and Ariel are stranded on a planet claimed by the Juireans. They want war and these guys are going to be in trouble.

I have read all 19 books in this series. They are hard to put down. Great Space Opera stuff with bigger than life heroes and heroines and excellent plots. It is escapist literature so if you are looking for "great science" find another author. This is entertainment at its imaginative best while still bearing some resemblance to believe-ability. I will probably read any book this author puts out.

I would give five stars to these books if the author ever figured out that his novels have to be proof read for grammatical mistakes which abound in all of his novels. I don't understand who is in charge but please someone edit these stories
