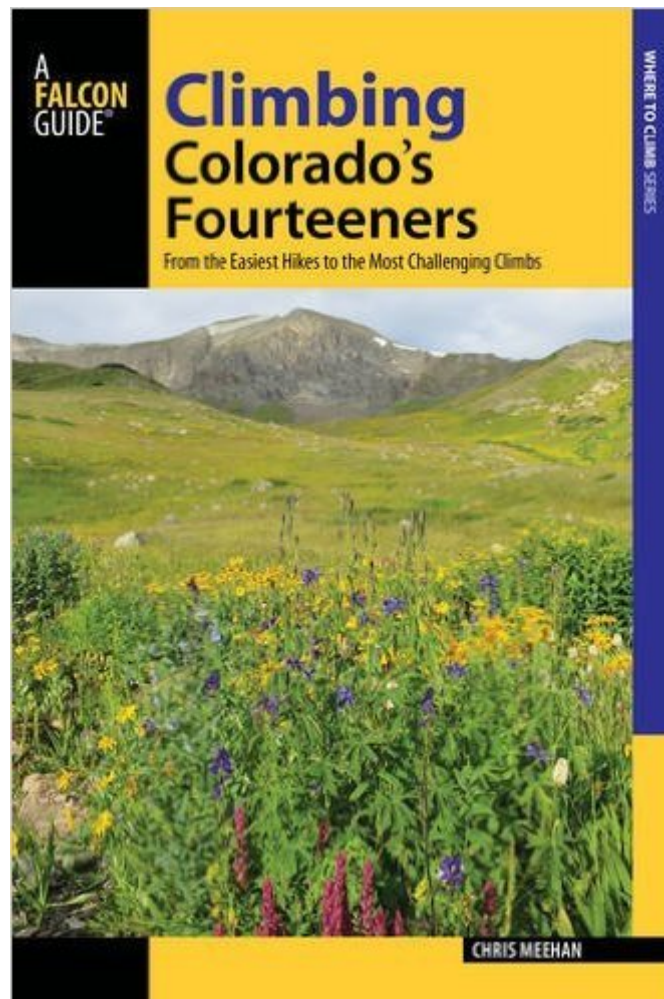


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# Climbing Colorado's Fourteeners: From The Easiest Hikes To The Most Challenging Climbs (Regional Hiking Series)
